Questions

1. Imaginative composition (Compulsory)

Either

- a) Write a composition ending with the following: (20Marks)

- ii) it must be a story if not deduct 2 marks
- iii) Must be written in first person experience
- iv) The composition should show the activity done by the writer and the punishment given which he/she was not given a second chance.

- b) Write an interesting composition with the following words;

Police, Friends, Court and Jail. (20Marks)

- i) It must be a story
- ii) Must be in first person point of view
- iii) Should give criminal offence done and all the words given should be in the composition.
- iv) Should not be less than 450 words

2. Write a composition on the following statements.

Technology advancement has impacted negatively on the society, especially the youth (20Marks)

- i) It should have an introduction and conclusion
- ii) Each way should be written on a separate paragraph
